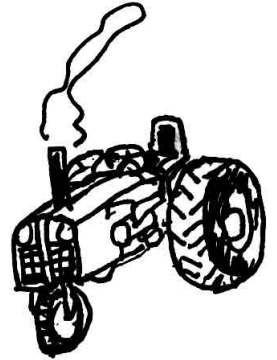

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

PLEASE SUBMIT VIA WITHOUTABOX.COM or by sending in this form!

Requirements:

The Rural Route Film Festival accepts all films and videos that can lay claim to a "rural" theme. This can be anything from a camping trip gone wrong comedy to a documentary about a Kansas farming family. The primary setting for the work should be rural, or within an ag-based city of 200,000 people or less. Works can be completed in any year, in any country, at any length. International submissions are encouraged – please inquire.

Enclosures:

All submissions must be accompanied by **4 items**:
1) a **completed entry form**, 2) an **NTSC/ALL REGIONS DVD** (which will only be returned if accompanied by a self-addressed stamped envelope), 3) a **short description** of how the term "rural" is defined in your work, and 4) a **submission fee**. Publicity materials are welcome but not necessary at time of submission – **if selected, you will need to provide stills in digital JPEG format (size req: 4x6", 300dpi), along with a synopsis and filmmaker bio.**

Permissions:

By submitting to the Rural Route Film Festival 2012, the filmmaker (or their representative) agrees that:

1. The Rural Route Film Festival is permitted to use the submitted video and any and all press materials of all selected entries for publicity and promotional purposes;
2. The Rural Route Film Festival is permitted to retain the submitted video for inclusion in our non circulating library;
3. The Rural Route Film Festival is not responsible for any materials submitted in any way;
4. That the person signing the entry form is legally authorized to enter this film in the Rural Route Film Festival 2012.

Screening Requirements:

Films can be shot in any medium. If selected, a final print in composite 35mm, 16mm, Super 8, HDCam, Digibeta, DVCam, mini-DV, or hi-res QT must be available by July 1st, 2012 at the filmmaker's expense.

Selection:

All submissions will be reviewed by the Rural Route Film Festival 2012 Selection Committee. **All selections are at the sole discretion of Rural Route Films.**
